I remember when we found out that my 11-year-old had a brain tumor, and they were going to have to operate immediately. Just minutes before surgery, Pastor Stewart was miraculously on the phone praying with us, right before a Sunday service. As they wheeled him away, my son's last words of comfort to his mother were.
