Matthew 7:7-11

For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. 9 Or what man is there among you who, when his son asks for a loaf, will give him a stone? 10 Or if he asks for a fish, he will not give him a snake, will he? 11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!

When we “ask” of the Lord, it is because we have no resources of our own. When we seek, we begin to take some responsibility in our requests. When we knock, we are not giving up in the pursuit of what we are asking and seeking. We know we are maturing in our prayer life when we are specific (in asking), confident (in seeking), and persistent (in knocking). Remember, we always receive an answer to our prayers. It may be a different answer than we were hoping for, but there is an answer.

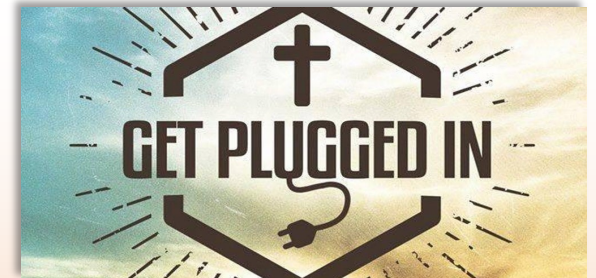
