From the Pastor



The New Testament calls the Christian life a “walk.” This walk begins with a step of faith when we trust Christ as our Savior. But salvation is not the end— it’s only the beginning—of spiritual life. “Walking” involves progress, and a Christian is supposed to advance in their spiritual life. Just as a child must learn to walk and must overcome many difficulties in doing so, a Christian must learn to “walk in the light.” The fundamental difficulty involved is the matter of sin. All of us must deal with our sins if we are to enjoy the life that is real. In First John, we see three approaches to sin.

I. We Can Try to Cover Up Our Sins

II. We Can Confess Our Sins

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. - I John 1:9

III. We Can Conquer Our Sins

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous; -1 John 2:1

The life that is real cannot be built on things that are deceptive. We must confess our sins and learn to conquer our sins by walking in the light. Before we can walk in the light, we must know ourselves, accept ourselves, and submit ourselves to God. It is foolish to try to deceive others because God already knows what we really are. All this helps to explain why walking in the light makes life so much easier and happier. When you walk in the light, you live to please only one Person—God. This really simplifies things!

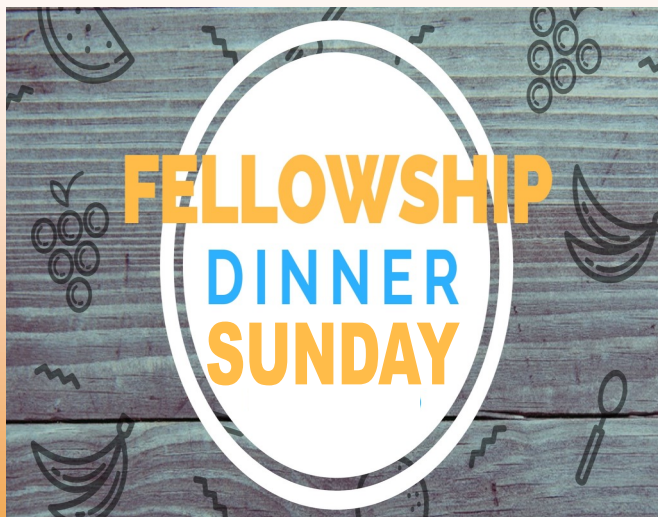
