One of the most important things I can do for others is...

Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love. 1 Corinthians 13:13

Be strong and let your heart take courage, all you who hope in the LORD. Psalm 31:24 (NIV)

### #1 Hope sets me free from my past.

#### My sin doesn't define me anymore.

Don't fool yourselves. Those who indulge in sexual sin, or who worship idols, or commit adultery, or are male prostitutes, or practice homosexuality or are thieves, or greedy people, or drunkards, or are abusive, or cheat people—none of these will inherit the Kingdom of God. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God. 1 Corinthians 6:11

#### I don't have to stay the same.

...but you were sanctified... 1 Corinthians 6:11

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! 2 Corinthians 5:17

# #2 Because of hope I can bounce back from my mistakes.

You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good. He brought me to this position so I could save the lives of many people. Genesis 50:20



## #3 Because of hope I am free to look to the future.

This is the day the LORD has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it. Psalm 118:24

Elijah sat down under a solitary broom tree and prayed that he might die. "I have had enough, Lord," he said. "Take my life, for I am no better than my ancestors." 1 Kings 19:3-4

Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake but the Lord was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire a sound of a gentle blowing. 1 Kings 19:12

Then the Lord told him, "Go back the way you came, and travel to the wilderness of Damascus. When you arrive there, anoint Hazael to be king of Aram. Then anoint Jehu to be king of Israel, and anoint Elisha to replace you as my prophet." 1 Kings 19:15-17
