Live life, then, not as those who do not know the meaning and purpose of life but as those who do. Ephesians 5:15

I'm here to love God back.

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." Mark 12:30

Loving God back is called WORSHIP.

"Those who worship God must worship in spirit and truth." -Jesus, John 4:24
