Jonah 1:1-14

"'We have all we want' is a terrible saying when 'all' does not include God." -C.S. Lewis (Problem With Pain)

What are the downsides of a self-willed life? I lose out.

"For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it." -Jesus, Matthew 16:25 (NLT)

Believe that God doesn't give up on anyone.

Then they took Jonah and threw him overboard and the raging sea grew calm.... But the LORD provided a great fish to swallow Jonah. Jonah 1:15, 17a

The raging sea grew calm. At this the men greatly feared the LORD, and they offered a sacrifice to the LORD and made vows to him. Jonah 1:16
