## What's Really Important to Me?

"In forty days you will be destroyed!" Jonah 3:4

Then Jonah went out to the east side of the city and made a shelter of sticks to sit under as he waited to see what would happen to the city. Jonah 4:5

And the LORD God arranged for a leafy plant to grow there, and soon it spread its broad leaves over Jonah's head, shading him from the sun. This eased his discomfort, and Jonah was very grateful for the plant. Jonah 4:6 (NLT)

The people of Nineveh believed God's message, and from the greatest to the least. Jonah 3:5

But God also arranged for a worm to eat through the stem of the plant so that it withered away. And as the sun grew hot, God arranged for a scorching east wind to blow on Jonah.
