Text: Mark 12:28-31

And one of the scribes came up and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, asked him, "Which commandment is the most important of all?" Jesus answered, "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." Mark 12:28-31 (ESV)

1) Have you ever felt Jesus standing in front of you asking, "Do you love Me, do you trust Me, will you follow Me?"

If yes, when was that time/where were you when that happened?

2) What are some things that could keep you from holding on to Jesus?

3) How do/will you let them go so that you can hold on to Him?

5) Who are some family or friends that you can stand with to strengthen their faith?

Close with prayer asking God to empower this group to hold on to Christ, support each other & grow in faith & service
