Better Together When We Tell Others

4.3.22

"Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." John 13:34-35

For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:19 (NLT)

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8 (NIV)

Action: Be one step bolder this week.

Action: Pray for someone in my life who I think, "no way."

God is in perfect control of where you are.

But the believers who were scattered preached the Good News about Jesus wherever they went. Acts 8:4 (NLT)

Ask for eyes to see your situation and how God can use it.



Eternal life is at stake

...And all who were appointed for eternal life believed. Acts 13:48 (NIV)

Action: Learn to be comfortable sharing the message.

What's he got to lose?

For the next two years, Paul lived in Rome at his own expense. He welcomed all who visited him, boldly proclaiming the Kingdom of God and teaching about the Lord Jesus Christ. And no one tried to stop him. Acts 28:30-31 (NLT)

I have nothing to lose.... And they have everything to gain.
