Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, a whenever you face trials of many kinds. James 1:2 (NIV)

#1 God wants me to be joyful.

"I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." -Jesus, John 15:11

#2 Joy and faith in Jesus Christ are deeply intertwined.

Rejoice in the Lord. I never get tired of telling you these things, and I do it to safeguard your faith. Philippians 3:1

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, ioy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self control. **Galatians 5:22-23**

#3 The capacity for joy in my life is determined by my closeness with Jesus.

How to increase my joy...

Remain close with God through time, attention, the Bible and prayer.

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers;" "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." -Jesus, John 15

Don't doubt the goodness of God.

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, a whenever you face trials of many kinds. Because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. You must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. James 1:3-4,6
