1) What are some crazy inheritances that you've heard of people leaving behind?

2) What is something you wish you would have inherited from family or a friend (besides loads of cash!)?

3) Read 1 Peter 1:1-13.

4) Curt described God's mercy as His pity He shows humanity in spite of our sin & because of our total helplessness to right our wrongs. What does it mean to you that God shows mercy when we trust Him rather than wrath?

5) In what ways do you celebrate the mercy God has shown you?

6) We've all experienced broken promises before, however, God's promise of salvation is "imperishable, undefiled & unfading" (1 Peter 1:4). In today's world that can seem so hard to believe. How can we trust that this is true?

7) Even though we hold to God's promises, it's easy for us to focus on all the wrongs going on around us – either personally, locally, nationally or in the world. Read Psalm 23. How does the writer of this passage contend with the concerns of his life?

What examples do 1 Peter 1:6-8 & Psalm 23 give us for going through trails & valleys?

8) Verse 8 describes the joy we will experience in heaven as "inexpressible & filled with glory" (ESV), can you even imagine what it will be like to see the risen Jesus & know that your faith is real?

9) How do you prepare your "minds for action" & be "sober-minded" (verse 13)? In what ways does this help you deal with the "even though" moments in your life?

10) Who is someone you can share this message with so that they can be encouraged in their faith today?

11) Take time to pray for & with each other
