FREE.

SECURE.

Open my eyes, so that I may see the wonderful truths in your law. Psalm 119:18

Hey, Future Me... Spend time with the Bible to be different.

All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. 2 Timothy 3:16

If you have these qualities and they are increasing, it demonstrates that your knowledge about our Lord Jesus Christ is living and productive. If these qualities aren't present in your life, you're shortsighted and have forgotten that you were cleansed from your past sins. 2 Peter 1:8-9
