This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. 1 John 4:9 (NIV)

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. 1 John 3:16 (NIV)

I let God love me when I accept what He has done for me through Jesus Christ.

And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. Ephesians 3:18 (NLT)
