## trials aren't sinful... they are neutral.

### temptations to sin are not sinful

when the inward sin leads to outward action, the action isn't your biggest problem... the <u>unseen desire</u> is what needs to be addressed

# 14 But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire.


rejecting or ignoring God in the world he created, rebelling against him by living without reference to him, not being or doing what he requires in his law.

## Every time we sin, we are actively partaking in the first sin by rebelling against God


## We aren't rebels because we rebel; we REBEL because we are REBELS

15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.


## we cannot gain victory over sin, if we won't admit what sin is



"Let's refer back to Superman. The substance that was dangerous only to him-it removed his strength and rendered him powerless—was kryptonite. Superman had abilities that were otherworldly."



"He was able to do supernatural feats and possessed paranormal knowledge, keen sensory awareness, extraordinary power, and unwavering character. However, if exposed to kryptonite, Superman became sick and weak-even weaker than the average human being. If exposed to it over a long period of time, he could even die..."



If sin is not dealt with, it can do to the believer what kryptonite could do to Superman, even to the point of death.


If we have any hope against our kryptonite, we have to fight it at the level it starts—your desires

### 3. THE TRIUMPH OF SIN

## 16 Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers.

## His kryptonite killed him, but yours will too… so deal with it today.

If the Spirit's job is to provide us with both the will and the power to do God's good purposes, then any time my desire fails to match up with his, it doesn't just call for self-disciplined obedience. It calls for spiritual realignment.
