Being on top in life is much better than living life at the bottom. As a Believer in Christ and in this world, it is God's will that you live victoriously, in-spite of the challenges we all face daily.

One of my favorite scriptures on this subject is found in II Corinthians 2:14, "Thanks be unto God who always causes us to triumph in Christ". Not triumph some of the time or most of the time, but triumph all the time. Oh, I can't tell you how many times that scripture has snatched victory out of satan's jaws of defeat on my behalf. The bible assures us that Jesus is a Victor and that you and I can share in His Victories!

Proverbs 4:7 - "Wisdom is the principal thing (divine insight concerning how we should live and what brings success); therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting get understanding."

I've been saying to Victory, that if you want to live a happy and joyous journey as a believer, tell satan to "Get behind you!" Jesus said it to one of His disciples (Peter), who was ignorantly being used by satan.

Satan who has been around a long time and is very subtle will try to bring distractions, deceptions, anxieties, issues, storms, temptations, forebodings, fear, worries and a host of other things into your mind to try and cause you to feel alone, incompetent, isolated and condemning.

Don't let satan burden you down with these thoughts and feelings, rather make a quality decision to get into the Word of God each day and allow the Word get in your mind (meditating on it) until you start experiencing and sensing God's peace, joy, and presence. James 4:7 says, "Submit yourself to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you".

Secondly, sing praises to God and listen to Christian

The circumstances of life will present opportunities to act as a wise or foolish person. There is one of two ways to travel through life, wisely or foolishly.

Life constantly presents decisions to make! When you don't know the way to go, cry out for wisdom; she will answer.

I want to close with a story called "The Wise Woman's Stone." A wise woman who was traveling in the mountains found a precious stone in a stream.

That helped take my mother's mind off the problems of the day and put her mind on the problem solver.

Lastly, make sure you are in church as much as possible. Hebrews 10:24 says, "And let us consider how we may spur one another on towards love and good deeds. Not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another and all the more as you see the
