The most significant way that the love of God will be seen shining, in the darkness of this world, is through the interactions and relationships of the Believers in Jesus Christ.

The way we treat our brothers and sisters in Christ and non-Believers in our immediate sphere of influence can be our greatest opportunity to develop a relationship.

We are empowered to love through our relationship with God. God loved us first, before we knew who Jesus was.

We were still sinners Romans 5:2 "Our faith guarantees us permanent access into this marvelous kindness (tender, gentle merciful), that has given us a perfect relationship with God."

As we grow in Christ, personal relationships can strengthen. In those relationships there will be conflict.

Nevertheless, we can still love our irritating family members, coworkers, neighbors, enemies, and friends because we do not love them in our natural ability, but in our supernatural love that comes from the Holy Spirit.

My favorite description is found in I Corinthians 13:4-8. Our Senior Pastor, Eric A. Susberry, when receiving new members, reminds them that their toes may be stepped on, but these social conflicts can be resolved.

There are no perfect churches and there are no perfect people if there were perfect once you or I would get there, it would no longer be perfect.

Paul and Barnabas for example did not agree on John Mark joining them on the missionary trip.

Paul was angry at Mark because he abandoned them while they were in Pamphylia. (Acts 15:37-38).

Barnabas felt that Mark had learned better and deserved another chance to redeem himself. Paul eventually wrote favorably of Mark in a letter to the Corinthians, (I Corinthians 9:5-6).

2 Timothy 4:11. "So whatever anger was felt at the start of the issue was resolved in love." As a member of V.I.C.K. Church I have been blessed to witness some issues resolved in love, during the fifteen years my family and I have been members of this body of Believers. Looking forward to seeing many more.

Dear Mother Eunice, I've learned that I can get fed spiritually by watching church online. I understand going to church when that is the only way to hear the Word. But things have changed, and we have options now. Do we still need to show up in person?

Your answer is found in another question: what is the church? Is it the pastor ministering and you listening? Is church a singular, personal activity? Or is there something more to it? In the book of Acts, we are presented with a clear vision of how a church is to operate. It is a place where people are healed, and needs are met. It is a place where people come together to pray and be encouraged. 1 Corinthians tells us that it is where your spiritual gifts can be recognized, developed, and used. It is a place for teaching, but also for correcting.

Paul describes the church as a body with many parts that are all needed. The implication is that the church does something with those parts; that it is active, not passive. The Lord did not save you for you to lock yourself in your house and never leave it. Church is an opportunity for you to be Jesus to someone in the unique way that God has created you.

Watching service online during Covid was wise. It forced everyone to think of ministry differently. But God created us for others and nothing about that fact has changed.
