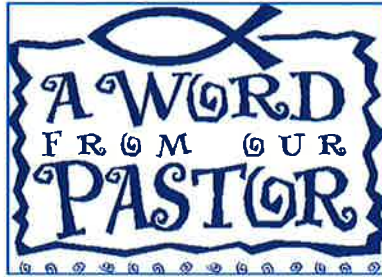

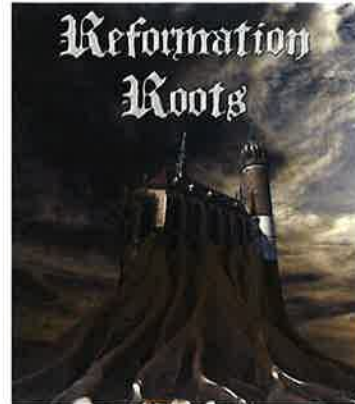
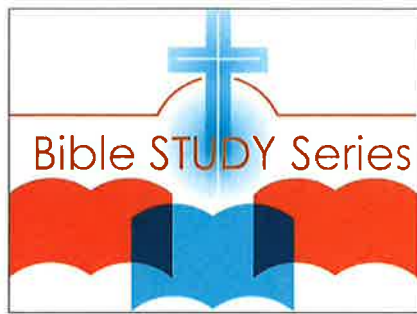

Shortly after I came to Prince of Peace, I did a Select Series entitled, "Reformation Roots". I thought it was a good time and would be fun to do it once more. The series asks these questions: "Do you ever wonder why we have so many Christian denominations, and, if there is really much difference between them? The answers to these questions lie in the dramatic and turbulent times of the Reformation. This high-definition series brings to life the stories and struggles that still impact us today."

One of the concerns that has been brought forward in the past and, on the recent survey that was done is what is the right time to hold studies such as this - daytime, or evenings. I decided I will hold the class twice on Mondays. The first class would be at 2:00 PM and the second at 6:00 PM. This is a twelve-part series but looking at the calendar's Mondays, holidays, vacation times, and council on the third Monday of the month, this class cannot be able to be held on twelve consecutive Mondays.

September 12<sup>th</sup> - Luther's Legacy (Bonus Session)  
October 10<sup>th</sup> - The Swiss Reformation  
October 24<sup>th</sup> - The Radical Reformation  
October 31<sup>st</sup> - The English Reformation  
November 7<sup>th</sup> - The Catholic Reformation

I hope that many of you will find this interesting and a learning experience to better understand more about how there have come to be so many different Christian denominations, as we continue to all worship the same Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

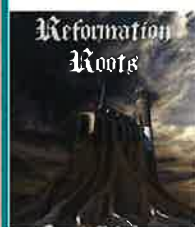

## Life Line Screening goes beyond regular checkups to look inside your arteries for signs of plaque build-up

#### **Carotid Artery Disease:**

An ultrasound is performed to screen the carotid arteries for buildup of fatty plaque.

#### **Peripheral Arterial Disease:**

An Ankle-Brachial Index (ABI) test is performed using blood pressure cuffs on the arms and legs.<sup>1</sup>

#### **Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm:**

An ultrasound is performed to screen the abdominal aorta for the presence of an enlargement or aneurysm.

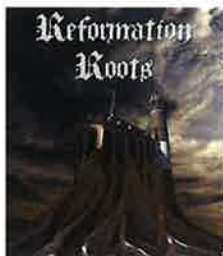

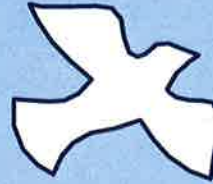
