**DATE CHANGE:** The **December Board Meeting** has been moved to Wed., December 12th at 6:00 p.m. Please make note of this change.

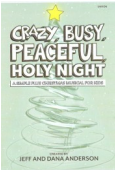
There will be **NO Area Men's Fellowship** in November or December.
