Brianna Grotts has an opportunity to travel on a Cross Cultural Project (CCP) with Campus Outreach to Johannesburg, South Africa this summer. Campus Outreach is a Christian Leadership Organization on college campuses throughout the United States as well as other countries worldwide.

CCP is an opportunity for college students to be exposed to ministry in another culture. Brianna will spend 6 weeks in South Africa with students and staff from the St. Louis Region mid-May through June. While there, time will be spent on college campuses building relationships and sharing the gospel with students. Typically, students in other countries have very limited exposure to the Bible, church, or gospel. Therefore, not only will she be learning and growing as a follower of Jesus, but there is a great need among students in South Africa to be reached.
