Mission of the Month: Shiloh Christian Children's Ranch

Last Sunday, the board met and approved the Youth Minister Search Committee’s recommendation to offer our youth minister position to Leonard “LJ” Martin. A congregation vote for church members will be held on March 28th to vote on offering him our full time youth minister position.

The Youth Minister Search Committee began collecting applications for the new youth minister late last summer after the board determined that the church’s needs would best be met by a full-time youth minister with a Bible college degree. Out of a pool of ten candidates, the committee selected three individuals and conducted virtual face to face interviews via Zoom.

LJ was selected as our top candidate. He seemed to be the best fit for the position and was invited to come and visit Burnside and the surrounding area for a weekend in February. While he was here, he had the opportunity to lead the high school Sunday school class and teach and lead the youth group in conjunction with the interim youth minister. He also had the chance to interact with the Elders and staff as well as members of the search committee.

LJ is a senior at Ozark Christian College and will graduate this May with a degree in Youth Ministry. He will be attending church with us on March 28th.

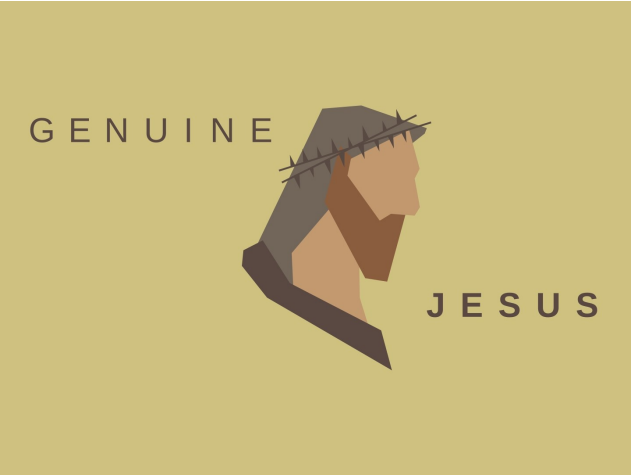
Wednesday: April Beacon Deadline
