Point 1: WHAT THE LORD HAS DONE TO HIS
SERVANT

Isaiah 53:10a (NASB95)

But the Lord was pleased to crush Him, putting
Him to grief;

PROFOUND TRUTH: *While men are doing the WORST that they can do, at the same time, God is doing the BEST that He can do.*

1 John 4:19 (NASB95)

We love, because He first loved us.

Point 2: A RECOGNITION OF THE SERVANT'S RESURRECTION (10b)

Isaiah 53:10b (NASB95)

He will see His offspring, He will prolong His days, and the good pleasure of the Lord will prosper in His hand.

Romans 10:9 (NASB95)

⁹ that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

Hebrews 2:9–10 (NASB95)

Jesus Briefly Humbled

⁹ But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, namely, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.

¹⁰ For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect the author of their salvation through sufferings.
