ABOUT THE SPEAKER - MARK BISHOP

Mark Bishop is the Sr Pastor at GracePointe Baptist Church. Prior to being called as revitalization pastor and doing a replant in January 2017, he served as a pastor in the Fort Knox area- growing both ministries by over 500%.

Pastor Mark previously served in the United States Army as both a combat engineer and a chaplain with multiple combat deployments. He still serves in the Army Reserves, currently serving as a Battalion Executive Officer.

He has an extensive background in revival and revitalization churches around the country, holding revivals in several hundred Baptist churches. Mark and Kim, married 24 years, have 3 children: McKenzie, Mark Wesley, and Mason. Mark earned a Bachelor of Arts from Pensacola Christian College in 1998, Master in Ministry from Liberty, and a Master of Missiology from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in 2015. Mark is projected to finish his Doctor of Missiology in December 2022. Pastor Mark also teaches at SBTS and Boyce College!


