Lori came in with her boyfriend after taking a test at home. She is a college student with a career path that she has been dreaming about. Having a baby, she feels, would not allow her to do that. Her boyfriend is supportive and admitted he feels responsible for where they are at. Abortion seems like the only way even though neither of them want to do that.

While discussing all her options, Lori became very interested in hearing about open adoption. I also encouraged her to have an ultrasound with the doctor a couple of weeks later to get a better estimate on how far along she was and to aid in her decisionmaking process. During the ultrasound, Lori was able to hear the heartbeat and her desire for an abortion has really declined.

The couple is still unsure about what direction they would like to take, but their hearts have been moved toward the life of their child and they continue to be in contact with the adoption agency as they set up Medicaid and find a doctor.



Kids to Love meets the immediate needs of foster children, and one way we do so is through emergency assistance. A foster mom named Karen called us for help with a pair of siblings who came into her care in the middle of the night. They had nothing but pajamas - not even shoes or underwear. Kids to Love outfitted both children with clothes, pajamas, a blanket, stuffed animal, a duffle bag and hygiene items.
