Things are truly at full speed in the Turtle Room!

Through the month of September we worked on sight words—finding them in texts, writing them, spelling them—reading patterned sentences with decodable words, and strengthening our letter sound knowledge. If there is one thing I have discovered about this class it is that they REALLY like having books read aloud, so we do quite a bit of that. The children are also learning about reading with inflection, so we have fun with our decodable sentences, reading them in all sorts of ways: surprised, silly, proud, grumpy, sad, nervous, happy. There are many giggles, but the point is making learning fun!

In math we worked on sorting, graphing, identifying shapes, and identifying and writing numbers. We spent some time learning about setting up the numbers 1-10 in ten frames so that we can count more quickly. We also played a game where each child was given a secret number and had to find that many objects to bring back to the group. The rest of the group then tried to "guess" the secret number by counting the number of items. All this counting practice is setting them up for bigger things in math!

We have also explored all of the possibilities of primary colors in art, blending them to make new colors and warming them up and cooling them down. The children enjoyed seeing all the variations of oranges and teals they were able to make.

When we return from Fall Break we will have the themes of Farm, Bugs, and Pumpkins! I'm looking forward to all of it! The children will keep building on their foundation of skills, learning about word families, blending sounds, understanding number sequence, and so much more.

As always, I continue to be thankful for the opportunity to invest in the lives of your children.
