

Isaiah 6

1. Isaiah's _____. (v.1-4)

- a. It was a personal crisis..
- b. It was a political crisis

Where did he see The Lord?—"sitting upon a throne".

i. That's the governing of God.

People often ask—Where is God in a crisis?

He is on the Throne!! Psal.47:8; Psal.93:2; Heb.8:1

—"high and lifted up".

ii. That's the greatness of God.

—"and his train filled the temple"..

iii. That's the glory of God.

Notice—The Angels Of God; Their Wings.

(v.2) "Above him were seraphim"..

—That's the radiance Of God, humility.

—"with two they covered their feet"...

—That's the reverence for God, holy.

Notice—The Attributes Of God; His Worship. (v.3)

Notice what Isaiah calls GOD—

"The king"—our ruler.
