

Dear future WEE families.

First off, thank you so much for choosing WEE and allowing us the opportunity to love and teach your child during the 2022-23 school year. Unfortunately, because of the pandemic we are having to do many things differently this year to ensure the health and safety of our staff and students. This in turn impacts the way we are having to do registration for new incoming students. The following will outline the process of turning in registration paperwork and payment.

- WEE Registration opens to the public on Monday, February 7, 2022 with drop off being between 9:00-11:00.
- Current WEE Covid policy does not allow anyone to enter the building so all paperwork and payment will be taken outside at the main WEE doors. (the first set of doors under the pull through, non-sliding doors)
- Masks are required at all times for adults.
- WEE operates a morning carline from 8:15-8:30, so we ask that nobody walks up before 8:45 to enable our current families to drop their children off at school.
- Please park in any available spot and do not park under the pull through.
- There will be 2 stations set up at the WEE entrance. One for Lambs 2 and one for 3 Kindergarten.
- We ask that when you arrive you find your appropriate station.
- At drop off we are only collecting registration forms and payment. Turning items in does not secure your spot.
- We will notify everyone by 3:00pm on Monday if they have secured a spot or been placed on the waitlist. We want to double check our openings, especially for those with siblings, before informing someone they were accepted.
- For those that are placed on the waitlist, we will hold your paperwork on file. You will have 3 options concerning your payment, it can be shredded, it can be mailed back to you, or you may pick it up the next day.
- Our WEE secretary is a notary so she will be able to notarize paperwork after drop off.
- After Monday 2/7, to turn in paperwork and payment you will need to come to the main WEE doors and ring the bell for assistance between the hours of 9:00-11:00 Monday-Friday. Acceptance/waitlist emails will be sent out the same day as drop off.

WEE Policy Agreements

- All classes are 8:15-12:30.
- Morning carline is 8:15-8:30. After 8:30 you must walk your child to the WEE entrance.
- Afternoon carline is 12:15-12:30.
- All students must be up to date on vaccinations. WEE does not allow for religious exemptions.
- All necessary forms and immunization records must be submitted prior to admission to the program. Immunization records must be kept current.
- Tuition is due the 1st of each month.
- A \$20 late fee will be charged if payment is received after the 8th.
- No refunds will be made for holidays, illness, or inclement weather closures or delays.
- A two week notice is required for withdrawal from the program.
- All 2's and under classes are nut free.
- All 3's and up must be <u>fully potty trained</u> and fully potty independent prior to the first day of school. (No pull-ups)
- Special Needs Policy: If WEE feels we are unable to adequately meet the needs of a child for whatever reason, the parents may be asked to withdraw the child and will be issued a refund.
- All families must abide by the WEE Covid Policy and WEE Handbook.
