During the July 2020 Greater Europe Mission Candidate Orientation in Colorado, David and I attended two days of support raising training. One topic that was never addressed, but has surfaced now, was the idea that donors might want their money back if something prevented David and me from fulfilling our mission. The GEM policy is that if something did prevent us from serving in Germany, donors would have the option of selecting another GEM missionary to receive their contribution, but there are no refunds. The idea that ministry partners might want a refund is quite troubling and places a heavy weight upon our shoulders. Contributions to missions are offerings to the Lord just like offerings given in church, and a church does not give refunds for tithes or offerings if the pastor retires and a new one takes his place. David and I, like all missionaries are merely pawns used to accomplish the Great Commission. We ask that you do not see us as the investment, but the work of the Lord as the investment. However, we realize that many of you already give abundantly to church, missions, and give offerings throughout the year. We are humbled and grateful that you are giving to us just because you know and love us. So GEM will allow us to collect pledges that will count toward our funding goal but will be held by the donor until our family is ready to leave for Germany.
