




SPREAD SOME CHRISTMAS CHEER!

Please list your name and your email address. Pastor Eddie will send you an introduction to each book we will be reading. We will read a chapter a day throughout the year. The principle is to read less and meditate more on our daily reading. In addition to the introductions, Eddie will send regular Bible reading and study helps.

The 2022 plan will take us through the historical narrative of the Old Testament beginning with Joseph (Genesis 37) and through the division between the northern tribes and the southern tribes of Israel (I Kings 14). It's a captivating history of how God interacted with His people. All four gospels, the book of Acts, three minor prophets, four New Testament letters, several of the Psalms, the Song of Songs and a few other timely chapters of the Bible are a part of the plan.
