The Last Supper - a Display of God's Faithfulness!

The 2022 performance of *The Last Supper* on Sunday, April 10 at 7:30pm, will mark the **20th presentation** by the congregation of First Presbyterian Church, Kannapolis! The original production of the tableau by Ernest Emurian took place on March 26, 1961, and showings have continued regularly in the 61 years since - yearly in the beginning, then most recently on a 3-year interval. 2018 marked the Church's most recent presentation. *The Last Supper* drama depicts Jesus and His 12 disciples, as imagined by artist Leonardo da Vinci, just after Jesus' announcement that one of the 12 will betray Him. In turn, the disciples "come alive" to ponder ... "Is it I?" Invite others and make plans to attend this moving worship service, as together we reflect on God's gift of salvation to all.



Donations for Ukraine relief are now being accepted, and will be sent to Samaritan's Purse. When the Russian invasion began, Samaritan's Purse was in the process of distributing 600,000 Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes. Their "disaster response specialists" are in place in Poland, Romania, and Moldova. Additionally, they are now setting up an Emergency Field Hospital outside Lviv, which is planned to include 2 operating rooms and almost 60 inpatient beds. Their desire is "to meet the needs of these families in their darkest moments while pointing them to the light and hope of Jesus Christ." 
