

Richard Jackson Wohlman (RJ) studied Violin Performance at Appalachian State, where he received his undergraduate and graduate performance degree, as well as an education degree. He performs with the Salisbury and Winston-Salem Symphonies. RJ is married to Katie and dad to Jackson and Lucy.

Timothy Gudger received his Bachelor of Music from Appalachian State University and his Master of Music from Duquesne University of the Holy Ghost in Pittsburgh, PA. Mr. Gudger has played extensively with orchestras in the southeast, including the North Carolina, Winston-Salem, and Greensboro Symphonies, the South Carolina Philharmonic, the Savannah Symphony Orchestra, and the Hilton Head Orchestra. He is now principal violist with the Salisbury Symphony and associate principal violist for the Western Piedmont Symphony.

Liz Burns received her undergraduate degree from UNC Charlotte and a Masters in Cello Performance from Winthrop University. She is adjunct professor of Cello at Winthrop where she also teaches Strings Methods and coaches the Cello Ensemble. In addition to acting as cello coach for the Youth Orchestras of Charlotte Preparatory, she serves as Assistant Principal of the Salisbury Symphony, director of the Salisbury Symphony Youth Orchestra, and regularly subs with the Charlotte Symphony Orchestra.
