WEDNESDAYS IN THE WORD resume February 7 at 6:30pm with a 6-week, Old Testament Survey for adults. The Rev. Dr. Trevor Smith will lead our study. Dr. Smith is a graduate of the College of William & Mary (AB), Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary (MDiv), and the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies/Middlesex University (PhD). He is the son and grandson of Presbyterian ministers and is currently serving at the Marshville Presbyterian Church after completing 42 years of pastoral ministry in Philadelphia, Stillman Valley, IL and Charlotte, NC. He resides in the Kannapolis area with his wife, Joany.

Our study will be based on C.A.S.K.E.T. - an Old Testament Survey created by Dr. Carol Kaminski of Gordon-Conwell. The survey allows us to see the "big picture" of the OT without getting lost in the details of genealogies, countless laws, lists of kings, where the prophets fit in, and the exiles endured by God's people. Just a handful of 'memory devices' provide a clear path from Genesis to Malachi and on into the New Testament.

Ministry Focus: Cabarrus Meals on Wheels (MOW)
Cabarrus Meals on Wheels is a non-profit organization that
provides well-balanced, nutritious meals, 5 days a week, to
eligible homebound seniors and individuals with disabilities.

Each of the 31 Cabarrus routes ideally needs a driver and a helper. Having daily face-to-face contact during the week allows

volunteers to develop relationships with those they are serving and provides a wellbeing check to alert of any potential problems. This in turn can help clients remain longer in their homes. Half of our monthly 10 Cents a Meal Collection is now designated for Cabarrus MOW, with the other half going towards our Compassion International children. Dave and Jane Argabrite, who have volunteered for Cabarrus MOW since September of 2018, would be happy to talk to you or let you ride along with them if you want more information!

The Missions Team has scheduled a Domestic Missions Trip in 2024! The site is in New Bern, NC for hurricane repairs. We are working with World Renew, an ECO partner. Work will begin on Tuesday, May 27th and continue through that week.
