Project 24 MARCH Update

Thank you to all who have supported Project 24. To date, we have raised just over \$77,000 of the \$100,000 to \$110,000 that is needed to complete the top two priorities!

Project 24 is the beginning of a multi-year effort to improve our church campus functionally and aesthetically. **The current focus is on two items:** (1) replace the 50+ year old heating and air conditioning system for the Fellowship Hall and third floor of the Education Building and (2) improve the Fellowship Hall restroom.


Other potential improvements will be prioritized and worked after these two items. The overall vision is to make the church property well-maintained, in good working condition, and more attractive for visitors.
