The Project 24 committee is working to line up contractors to do the top two priorities, which are to replace the heating and air conditioning system for the Fellowship Hall/ Education Building and to improve the Fellowship Hall restroom. The team hopes to be able to share an estimated timeline for the work soon.

To date, we have raised approximately \$79,000 toward the \$100,000 to \$110,000 that is needed for the top two priorities.
