





THE WEEKLY FIRST



“Practice hospitality” (Romans 12:13). This is the theme for Sunday. In our Bible reading and study, when there is a familiar word like “hospitality”, used in our culture, churches and the Bible, as a Bible teacher, I try to give Biblical meanings for biblical words. If there was ever a biblical word that demands this, it is “hospitality”. Henry Nouwen captures this sentiment. “Hospitality has lost much of its power and is often used in circles that expect tea parties, bland conversation and watered down piety. Still if there is a concept worth restoring to its original depth and its evocative potential, it is Biblical hospitality.” (Henry Nouwen) Sunday, from Romans 9:13 and Luke 14, we will consider the “original depth” and “evocative potential” of Biblical hospitality.




"Christmas" Themed Bridal Shower
