This Sunday I am ending the current series, "Praying the Psalms". Michelle and I are beginning to work on putting the series into print in the form of a devotional. The concluding Psalm we will consider is Psalm 100. Our focus will be on "praying our thanksgiving.

"Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. For the Lord is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations." (Psalm 100)

Psalm 100 is known by lots of people who may not even be aware they know the Psalm. In 1556 William Keith, as well as many British clergy, fled from England to Geneva Switzerland to escape the maniacal wrath of Queen Mary (1553-1558). Upon Keith's return to England in 1561, he introduced the hymn tune OLD HUNDRETH to the words of Psalm 100. We sing the hymn tune regularly when we sing the Doxology.

Psalm 100 is an invitation to be a people of worship and thanksgiving. Learning to be a person of thanksgiving is not only honoring to the Lord but can be transforming in our lives and community.

We need 193 wireless composition books, 112 packs of 24 ct crayons; 151 packs of skinny markers; 281 packs of pencils, 281 pencil sharpeners, 233 glue sticks and 352 pair of scissors. If you would like to contribute towards these items or the cost of shipping our boxes (\$10/box) you can do so online; or mark your donation "Shoeboxes" and place it in the offering plate.

If you would like to pack your own shoebox, boxes will soon be in the Narthex, or use one from home, and grab an instruction guide. Return your packaged box with the \$10 shipping cost inside, by Sunday, November 10.
