


THE WEEKLY FIRST




This Sunday we begin a new series, "The Moses Story". The series will be different from my two previous series: the "Fruit of the Spirit" and "Praying the Psalms" series. In these series, I taught on an attribute of God's Spirit, from a smaller passage of Scripture or a single Psalm. In "The Moses Story" we will read and review large portions of Scripture often encompassing an expansive swathe of God's redemption history.

Our series will remind us of the remarkable way God has revealed His perfect Word to us. The Bible is composed of 66 books, written by some 40 human authors, in three languages, mainly Hebrew (OT) and Greek (NT), in multiple literary genres, from and to people on several continents over a 1500 year period. And it reveals a single narrative! God's revelation of God's story of redemption.

This Sunday we will begin at the beginning, Exodus 1-2 and see God's preservation and preparation of God's leader/deliverer, Moses. It would be helpful to read Exodus 1-2 in preparation for the beginning of "The Moses Story".


"Christmas" Themed Bridal Shower
