We are continuing our Operation Christmas Child collection this month, having set our goal to once again pack 400 shoeboxes -200 for girls aged 2-4, and 200 for girls aged 10-14. For September, our collection will be personal care items! Our goal is to collect 400 hairbrushes, 16 washcloths, 382 regular sized bars of soap, 398 packs of hair accessories (like clips, pins,

or small bows), and 362 toothbrushes. We would also like to give small water bottles to the older girls (we still need 120) and a dinnerware set for the younger girls (We will order - approx. \$2.83 each on Amazon).
