


# THE WEEKLY FIRST



#### Remember to change your clocks Saturday night!!



This Sunday, November 3, we will remember and give thanks for those in our church family who have entered the undimmed glory of God's presence. We have lost dear folks this year. In Christ we are confident they are more alive than we can imagine.

Sunday is also a day many Christians pray for the international persecuted church. Globally, millions of Christians face persecution for their loyalty to Jesus Christ. Persecution comes in the forms of martyrdom, arrests, physical and emotional abuse, financial marginalization, just to name a few. During our celebration of the Lord's Supper you will be asked to pray for Christians around the world who are persecuted.

We will end Part 1 of the "Moses Story" this Sunday. I hope to teach Part 2 in 2025. Last Sunday we left God's people near a place called Pi Hahiroth (Ex. 14:2). As a newly freed people, they began their journey to God's destiny. God instructed them to camp at a place surrounded by the sea and the mountain, Baal Zephon. Pharoah had changed his mind about the Jews' freedom and commissioned his chariots and soldiers on a mission of annihilation. At Pi Hahiroth God's people panicked. All they could see was the mountain, sea and Pharoah's chariots of death. "They said to Moses, 'Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us to the desert to die? What have you done to us by bringing us out of Egypt? Didn't we say to you in Egypt, 'Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians'? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!" (Exodus 14:11-12) They had been freed by God's mighty hand only to be enslaved by their own fear. It is possible to have freedom but still live enslaved. We will continue this theme on Sunday as we prepare to culminate our worship with the celebration of the Lord's Supper.


### **Sunday Bulletin** is Online!
