# Our Thanksgiving Day lunch is TOMORROW Thursday, November 28!

The meal starts at 1:00pm in the Fellowship Hall.

As we celebrate our Thanksgiving with our family and friends, we also prepare to celebrate Advent and Christmas. This Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent. The Season of Advent is a four-week period before Christmas Day to spiritually consider and celebrate the Advent of our Lord. Historically, the four-week celebration of Advent begins on the Sunday closest to November 30 and progresses to Christmas Eve, December 24. Subsequently comes the "12 Days of Christmas" celebration. For those who follow the church year closely, the focus of their worship during the season of Advent is on the preparation for the coming of Christ. The term "Advent" derives from the Latin word, "adventus," which is translated in English as "coming" or "arrival."

Advent at First Presbyterian is more of an Advent and Christmas celebration. Our Advent themes this year are "Hope", "Peace", "Joy" and "Love" with hope as Sunday's theme. I will be teaching on hope from Isaiah 9. We will culminate our service of worship with the celebration of the Lord's Supper.



The Joy Group will meet for a Christmas Lunch at the home of Ron & Alpha Barger on Wednesday, December 18 at noon.


We will also have a "White Elephant" exchange. Each person should bring a wrapped gift costing less than \$10 to play in the exchange.
