I pray for God's blessings on you, our church family and our participation in Christ Kingdom mission into 2025. We have prepared two Bible reading plans for your consideration in 2025. One plan is to read one and sometimes 2 chapters daily through the NT plus the poetic books of the Bible. The other plan is to read the entire Bible in a year with daily readings through a mixture of OT and NT books of the Bible. I pray God will give us as a church family a greater hunger and thirst for the Scriptures and the God of the Scriptures.

This Sunday it will be cold outside but the heat in the sanctuary is working great. We are beginning the New Year with a Sunday teaching series on the NT book of Galatians. In Acts 13-14, the Apostle Paul and others went on their first missionary journey. Jews and Gentiles in Galatia heard and believed the gospel and new churches were started. When Paul and his team left the area and continued their missionary journey, other religious teachers, "Judaizers" came into these newly planted churches and taught a different message. To be accepted by God you must believe in Jesus plus the OT law and the practice of circumcision.

This is the occasion that prompted the letter to the Galatians. In Galatians, as Tim Keller notes in his brief and excellent commentary on Galatians, the gospel is not just the ABC's of conversion or becoming a Christian, the gospel is the A-Z of the Christian life. It is the message revealed in the Scriptures and the spiritual foundation and power for living and participating in Christ's Kingdom mission. The passage on which the teaching is based this Sunday is Galatians 1:10-12.

There are many opportunities for studying God's Word together in Sunday School. Children's classes continue to meet on the third floor for Preschoolers through Middle Schoolers.
