


THE WEEKLY FIRST



As part of our Sunday worship during January and February, I am teaching a series on the New Testament letter to the Galatians. As the gospel of Christ expanded out of Jerusalem and Judea into Asia Minor, God used the Apostle Paul and others to evangelize and plant churches in Galatia (present day Turkey). In Galatia, Jews and Gentiles heard and believed the transforming gospel of Christ. They began forming unprecedented and counter-cultural communities in which "there is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus." (Galatians 3:28)

This created a crisis in the Christian movement, especially in Jerusalem. What was at stake was the nature and content of the gospel of Jesus itself. Are people righteous/accepted by God by faith in Christ alone? What about Gentiles being converted out of pagan religion? Do they need to follow Jewish law and cultural practices? What is the "truth of the gospel" (Galatians 2:5)? Is the Gospel "God's grace plus nothing" – God's grace alone, in Christ alone, received by faith alone, as revealed in Scripture alone, and lived out together by the spiritual power of Christ in us? Or is the gospel Jesus plus the Old Testament law; essentially becoming a cultural Jew?

In our passage this Sunday, Galatians 2:1-10, Paul is remembering a crisis in the early church about this very issue. We will consider the issue and glean some insights from the gospel for dealing with conflicts in our own lives and relationships.

This Wednesday, Jan. 22, at 6:30pm, you are invited to a New Year Prayer Gathering. During our time together, I will give a brief review of 2024 and we will spend time in prayer for our spiritual lives, church, community, nation and God's global mission. At the same time, children and youth are invited to music rehearsal with Michelle in the Sanctuary.
