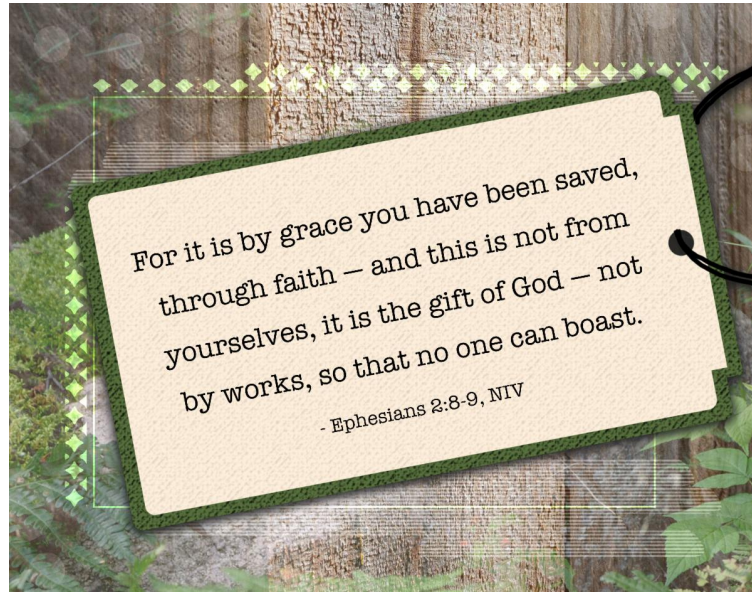




THE WEEKLY FIRST

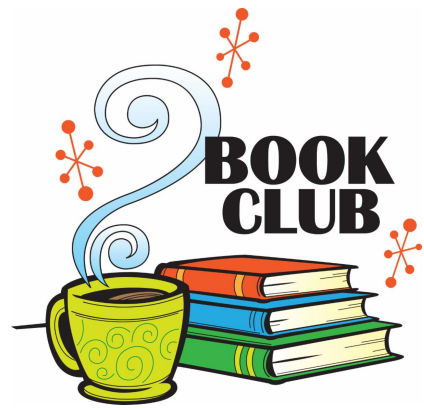


First Presbyterian will present a Living Dramatization of Leonardo DaVinci's *The Last Supper* on Sunday, April 13.
