


THE WEEKLY FIRST



Our summer-long combined adult Sunday school begins this Sunday, June 1. Breakfast will be shared at 9:30, followed by a presentation from Jane Daniel of the Cabarrus Women's Center. Throughout the summer, there will be mission-focused speakers during the Sunday school hour three or four times. Most other Sundays, I will be teaching.

During our worship this Sunday, the topic of Christian hope will be continued, based on Titus 2:11-14, focusing on our "blessed hope" (2:13). The series has defined and delineated the word "hope" as used in everyday life compared to the Christian idea of hope in the Bible. The English word "hope" reflects an eager expectation for a positive outcome and is rooted in human will, expressed through thinking and attitudes.

Christian hope is characterized as "confidence in the present due to certainty about the future". It is not rooted in self-will but rather in our trust in our grace-produced identity in Christ and the assurance of our "blessed hope—the appearance of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ" (Titus 2:13). On Sunday, we will reflect on the passage from Titus to understand more deeply how our belief in the future "blessed hope" shapes how we live now. Our worship will conclude with the celebration of the Lord's Supper.


