


## THE WEEKLY FIRST




There are three Bible Reading Plans available for you in **2026!** The plans are designed to encourage daily Bible Reading and time meditating on God's Word.

- The 2026 Bible Reading Plan focuses on the New Testament, with Old Testament readings from Psalms, Proverbs, and Ecclesiastes.
- The Bible in a Year Mixed Readings takes you through the entire Bible in one year. Each week, you will read from an Epistle, Old Testament Law, Old Testament History, Psalms, Poetry, Prophecy, and a Gospel.

• The Bible in a Year – Chronological Plan takes you through the entire Bible in one year. It is arranged chronologically, so you read events, psalms, and letters in the order in which they occurred.


