
**Guardians Class**, led by Raegan Swaringen and Ron Lisenby is currently studying the Gospel of Luke.

- **The Bible in a Year – Chronological Plan** takes you through the entire Bible in one year. It is arranged chronologically, so you read events, psalms, and letters in the order in which they occurred.


