

# Worship Ministry News

He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear, and put their trust in the LORD. Psalm 40:3 (ESV)

When David wrote these lines, he may have been referring to an actual *new song* since he wrote so many of them. Or he could have been referring to a new revelation of God's work in his life. Either way, the end result was that the song praised God and pointed people to putting their trust in Him.

Each of the great hymns of our faith was at one time a *new song* when it was first introduced to congregations. According to crosswalk.com, most of the Top 15 Favorite Hymns are centuries old. The newest, *Because He Lives*, was written in the 1960's. Many of us learned these songs by being in church Sunday morning, Sunday night and Wednesday night where hymn singing was part of most services.

God is still moving through the pens and instruments of men and women today to create *new songs* pointing to what He is doing in and through this generation. Our time together in corporate worship services is much shorter than a generation ago. The Christian community often learns *new songs* through Christian radio or the different streaming platforms. If you have ever felt that everyone around you in church knew the words to a song but you didn't, it's likely that they had already heard it in one of these ways.

Locally, radio stations like KPSM (99.3), KGNZ (88.1) and KBUB (90.3) offer Christian music. SiriusXM Radio offers three Christian channels: The Message (Contemporary Christian), Enlighten (Southern Gospel) and Kirk Franklin's Praise (Traditional Gospel).

SiriusXM comes, at least, as a trial in many vehicles and is included in most satellite television subscriptions.

Christian music of all genres can be accessed through streaming services on your phone, tablet or computer. Some of the most popular are Spotify, Pandora, and Apple Music. YouTube has the Billboard Top 50 Christian Songs available each week. It is easier than ever to add Christian music to your daily devotion time, driving time, workout time and recreational time. You don't have to wait until Sunday morning to sing praises to God!

We encourage you to let 2022 be the year that you sing a *new song* of praise to God. We hope that you will take advantage of some of the ways to bring Christian music into your home, your car and your day.
