Words of Encouragement....

Mark 2:3-5 – Some men came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, "Son, your sins are forgiven." [NIV]

In Mark 2:1-12, Mark tells the story of the paralyzed man whose friends bring him to Jesus. Why did they bring their friend who could not get there on his own? Because they believed Jesus could make their friend whole. For them, that meant being able to walk again.

When they arrived, there was already such a crowd of people that they couldn't get access to Jesus. There was no room in the house, no room at the doorway, and no one would even make way for them through the crowd to get to Jesus. Since no one would clear a path, they came-up with a hair-brained idea of taking their friend up on the roof.

Four people carrying a person around the crowd and up on the roof would not have been easy and would have created some commotion. And when they got there, what did they do? They started hacking and digging through the straw, sticks and mud of the roof top. Now you know this would have been very disruptive to Jesus' teaching and a serious inconvenience for those inside and under that roof as chunks of it began to fall! But they finally made a hole big enough to lower the guy down.

While all this was happening... the noise and ruckus of digging on the roof, the dirt and pieces of roof falling on people and on the floor, a guy being lowered through the newly fashioned hole... Jesus was just watching. And do you know what He saw? Faith! Yep, Mark says that "Jesus saw their faith." And for their faith, Jesus gave forgiveness.

When Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "Your sins are forgiven," that made the heads of the religious snobs explode! (Figuratively speaking.) It blew their minds and really irritated them. How dare Jesus say or do anything like that!

Jesus perceived what they were thinking in their prideful, resistant, and unbelieving hearts. So, He asked them a question: Which is easier to do, to say to a person "your sins are forgiven," or to heal a paralyzed person so he can walk again?

To show that both were in His authority and power to do, Jesus said to the paralyzed man: Rise up. Pick up your mat. And get going. And he did... right through the front door!

There are several things in Mark's account of this miracle that stand-out to me:

- These 5 friends (including the paralytic man) very intentionally and purposefully sought-after Jesus. If you are going to pursue and follow Jesus, you must do it with intent and purpose, like these guys did.
- Following Jesus isn't always straight-forward. There will be obstacles in your path. Sometimes the obstacles are circumstances. Sometimes they are people. Sometimes they are barriers.
- Following Jesus can be difficult and messy. It could tear-up your roof and mess-up your floor.
- Following after Jesus often does not look like what we thought it would (or should).
- What the Lord is looking for from all of us is faith. Following the Lord begins *in faith...* and continues *in faith.* We are to walk by faith! The author of Hebrews reminds us of this in Heb. 11:6 that, "without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him." The Lord looks for faith in us and rewards that faith.
- And lastly, the Lord always does much more in us and for us than we could ever expect. These guys were hoping and believing that Jesus could fix this man's legs so he could walk... and He did. But Jesus did much more and changed this man's heart so he could walk forever in a relationship with God.

So, dear believer, rise up in faith and start walking. Blessings to you in your journey of faith and following.
