Mark 4:14-20  $\succ$  "The sower sows the word. These are the ones who are beside the road where the word is sown; and when they hear, immediately Satan comes and takes away the word which has been sown in them. And in a similar way these are the ones sown with seed on the rocky places, who, when they hear the word, immediately receive it with joy; and yet they have no firm root in themselves, but are only temporary; then, when affliction or persecution occurs because of the word, immediately they fall away. And others are the ones sown with seed among the thorns; these are the ones who have heard the word, but the worries of the world, and the deceitfulness of wealth, and the desires for other things enter and choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful. And those are the ones sown with seed on the good soil; and they hear the word and accept it and bear fruit, thirty, sixty, and a hundred times as much."

I recently preached a message from this passage about the parable of the Sower and the Seed. And as I mentioned then, I suspect the vast majority of times this parable has been studied and explained, it was from the perspective that Jesus is talking about the person (the heart) that becomes saved versus those that do not. While that certainly would be a part of the meaning of this parable, I believe its meaning is much broader and applicable to all of us every day.

This parable is not merely about those who "get saved." This parable is really about the "readiness" of a person's heart to receive the word of God (His message to us), whether that person is lost or saved. The explanation of this parable offered by Jesus here in Mark 4:14-20 clearly identifies the "word of God" as the seed in the story.

If a person is lost without Christ, and the word of the "good news" comes to him, then the nature of the soil (the heart) influences the response of that person to the seed (the word) that is sown. Salvation, then, only occurs for the one in whom the seed "bears fruit," not for the other three responses.

For those of us who have been born again, the same heart-readiness is required every time God's word (God's message) comes to us. God is looking for those whose hearts are ready to receive the word He has for them. And, as in the parable, there are a number of things in our lives that could prevent and choke out what God wants to do in our lives.

Only one heart-response bears fruit. Only one condition of the soil is ready to receive and respond to the message (the word) from God. The other three conditions of the heart will keep us from bearing the fruit God desires from us. Satan is still in the business of "snatching away" the seed God is sowing. Satan still tries to keep God's word from taking root in our hearts and seeks to choke it out by the worries and vane pursuits of this world that clutter our lives.

Again, the real issue is the nature and condition of the soil (the heart). God is regularly sowing His word (seed) into our hearts. He speaks His message through the Word of God that you read, through a sermon that you hear, through the lessons taught in Scripture, through a friend who brings you encouragement, and through countless other ways every day.

So, how is your heart-readiness for the message (the word) God wants to sow in your life? He wants your heart to receive His word and allow it to bear fruit in and through your life.

I know God is ready, willing... and still sowing His Word in your heart.

Blessings to you on this journey of keeping your heart ready to receive the word God has for you.

Hey Church,




