How wonderful God has been to our church fellowship this past year! He has poured-out blessing upon blessing in 2022:

We have baptized 12 people who have confessed Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

We have received 44 new members into our church fellowship (the most in one year in more than a decade).

Due to faithful giving, not only have we met all of our budgetary needs, we have also had regular monthly surpluses.

This year, through the month of November, we have been able to put \$25,558 into our savings accounts, and \$22,057 into our activity accounts for various ministry efforts.

Above the church's regular monthly giving, we have received more than \$28,000 in special offerings towards missions and outreach ministries.

We had great summer camps for our pre-teens and youth.

There were successful outreach efforts to our community through "Back-to-School Blessings" in August and "First Blessings" in December.


