Words of Encouragement....

John 14:6 \triangleright Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." [NIV]

A recent Jim Denison article in <u>The Denison Forum</u> (Mar 6, 2023) captured my attention. In that article several poignant observations were made concerning "truth" in our culture and our response as Christians.

The very notion of truth has been minimized, diluted, and distorted in our culture. For example, abortion is often referred to as "lifesaving care," sex change surgeries are now "gender-affirming care," euthanasia is "death with dignity." If you defend the unborn, then you're accused of engaging in a "war on women." Supporting biblical marriage is now considered "homophobic." Those who believe women should not have to compete against biological men in sporting events are judged "transphobic."

Euphemisms like these don't change the truth. Just because some declare their perceptions and preferences as reality, doesn't make it so. A lie is still a lie regardless of how many people choose to believe it. However, a lie can still shape reality. The lies espoused by Hitler and the Third Reich brought about the death of millions of people. And when our secularized culture bombards us with messages that reinterpret truth according to its chosen fictions, its fictions become the guiding principles.

Christians should not be surprised by this, since "we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places" (Eph 6:12).

Satan is the "ruler of this world" (John 12:31) and the leader of these "spiritual forces of evil." He specializes in lies and deception because "there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies" (John 8:44).

Satan is good at his job: "The god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God" (2 Cor 4:4). And he has been especially busy in recent years, convincing millions of Americans that biblical truth and morality are outdated, irrelevant, and even dangerous.

Recent statistics bear this out. Recent Gallup surveys (2021 & 2022) reported that:

- The percentage of people who believe in God has dropped from 98 percent in the 1950's to 81 percent today.
- Only about half of Americans believe in "God as described in the Bible."
- Congregational membership is at an all-time low. For the first time ever, fewer than half of Americans are members of a church, synagogue, or mosque.
- ◆ About 1 in 5 adults say they have no religious affiliation. That's up from 1 in 50 in 1960.

So, what does this mean for you and me?

1st, we must stop measuring truth by popularity. The next time you find yourself on the wrong side of the crowd, remember that the crowd demanded the crucifixion of Jesus (John 19:15), and the majority voted not to go into the promised land (Num 13-14).

 2^{nd} , stand for truth with compassionate courage. People who reject biblical truth are not enemies of the Lord, but victims of the devil.

3rd, remember what the Lord has promised us: "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" (John 8:31–32).

In his book, <u>The Pursuit of God</u>, A. W. Tozer observed that, "one hundred pianos all tuned to the same [tuning] fork are automatically tuned to each other.... They are of one accord by being tuned, not to each other, but to another standard to which each one must individually bow."

So, tune your soul to our loving Savior and Lord, not to a fallen society.
